

**R.E.A.D. & R.E.A.P.  
Bible Reading Group**

1. Surefooted Ministries is reaching out to all those in the body of Christ who are searching for a Bible reading plan, that will keep them in the word of God consistently throughout the week.
2. Believers are struggling to read God's word on a regular basis. Furthermore to be a strong effective Royal Prayer Guard consistent Bible reading is of the utmost importance.
3. Bible reading should be a way of life. (*Like that cup of coffee some people love every morning*)
4. Surefooted Ministries has now made available R.E.A.D. and R.E.A.P.
5. If you are a believer that is struggling to read the Bible on a regular basis, **R.E.A.D. and R.E.A.P.** could be for you.
6. We know we should read God's word but for some reason we get distracted, things come up; our job gets *very* busy and even dangerous for those in law enforcement and the military.
7. Then we find ourselves chasing the Bible all day and all week feeling guilty and undernourished.
8. The answer to this sticky situation is simple. All you need is an effective Bible reading plan and someone to hold you accountable.
9. You also need someone who knows how to come against the enemy in the spirit realm on your behalf. [\*\*\(In other words exercise delegated authority\)\*\*](#)
10. From a law enforcement or military perspective how would it be if they never went on the attack against the enemy?
11. Pray for God's direction in your life involving regular Bible reading.

**Ephesians 5:15-17 (RSV)**

<sup>15</sup> Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise men but as wise,

<sup>16</sup> making the most of the time, because the days are evil.

<sup>17</sup> Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is.

15. Plus we are **sowing** good seed and if we are consistent and not grow weary we will **reap** a great harvest.

16. Therefore let us not grow weary in well doing (*daily reading*) for in due season we will reap a harvest. Our harvest will benefit not only us but others as well.
